Do you have a family member with an intellectual or developmental disability?

Or a physical disability or medical condition that makes rapid and easy mobility difficult?

- Is your loved one prone to wandering?
- Does he or she have difficulty communicating?
- Blind or deaf?
- Medically fragile?
- Struggling with Alzheimer's Disease or dementia?
- Does his or her emotional condition or anxiety level hinder quick decision making in a dangerous situation?

Consider registering with the Department of Emergency Services and Technology for St. Mary's County.



In the event of a disaster – fire, flood, hurricane, storm – or if your loved one tends to wander - you want your loved one to be protected and safe. Entry into the Functional Needs Database gives First Responders relevant information that may aid in saving your loved one's life and enhancing their well-being.
